Shopping in York, also there is a retail Outlet centre just outside.

Many Antique shops.

The Shambles. Narrow medieval streets with something for everyone.

York Cathedral.

Castle Museum.

Jorvic Viking Centre (very interesting), York Dungeon.

Many more old buildings and museums etc. in York.

Castle Howard (Brideshead re-visited).

Many more Houses and gardens.

Riveaux Abbey, Fountains Abbey, (remains courtesy of Henry XIII).

Ampleforth Abbey. A living monasterial community with a college, shops, cider, Cider Brandy, pub and more.

For rail enthusiasts. National Rail Museum York, North York Moors Railway.

NYM Railway from Pickering goes to Whitby (certain trains) also Goathland (Heartbeat).

Coast. Whitby, Scarborough etc.

Goathland is where Heartbeat is filmed and is the ancestral home of the Stanforths.

Yorkshire Air Museum (has an intact Halifax).

York Cold War Bunker.

Eden Camp (WW2 attraction in an old POW Camp). (interesting)
